

## **RUNNING THE *ERGONOMICS: HOW MAY WE HELP YOU?* CD IN WINDOWS VISTA**

In order to run the *ERGONOMICS: HOW MAY WE HELP YOU?* CD in Windows VISTA, the following steps will need to be performed:

- 1 Go to the Control Panel
- 2 Open User Accounts

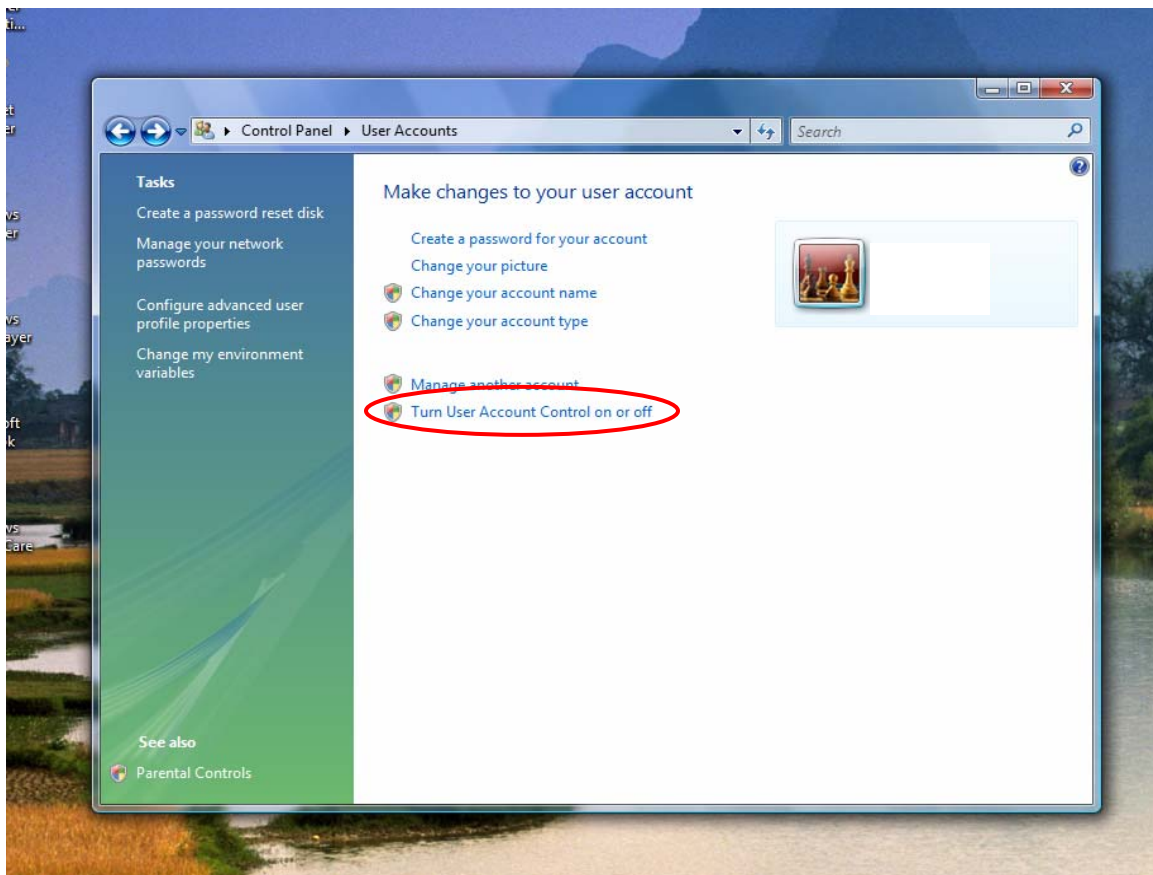


FIGURE 1—TURN THE USER ACCOUNT CONTROL OFF

- 3 Click onto 'Turn User Account on or off' (Figure 1)

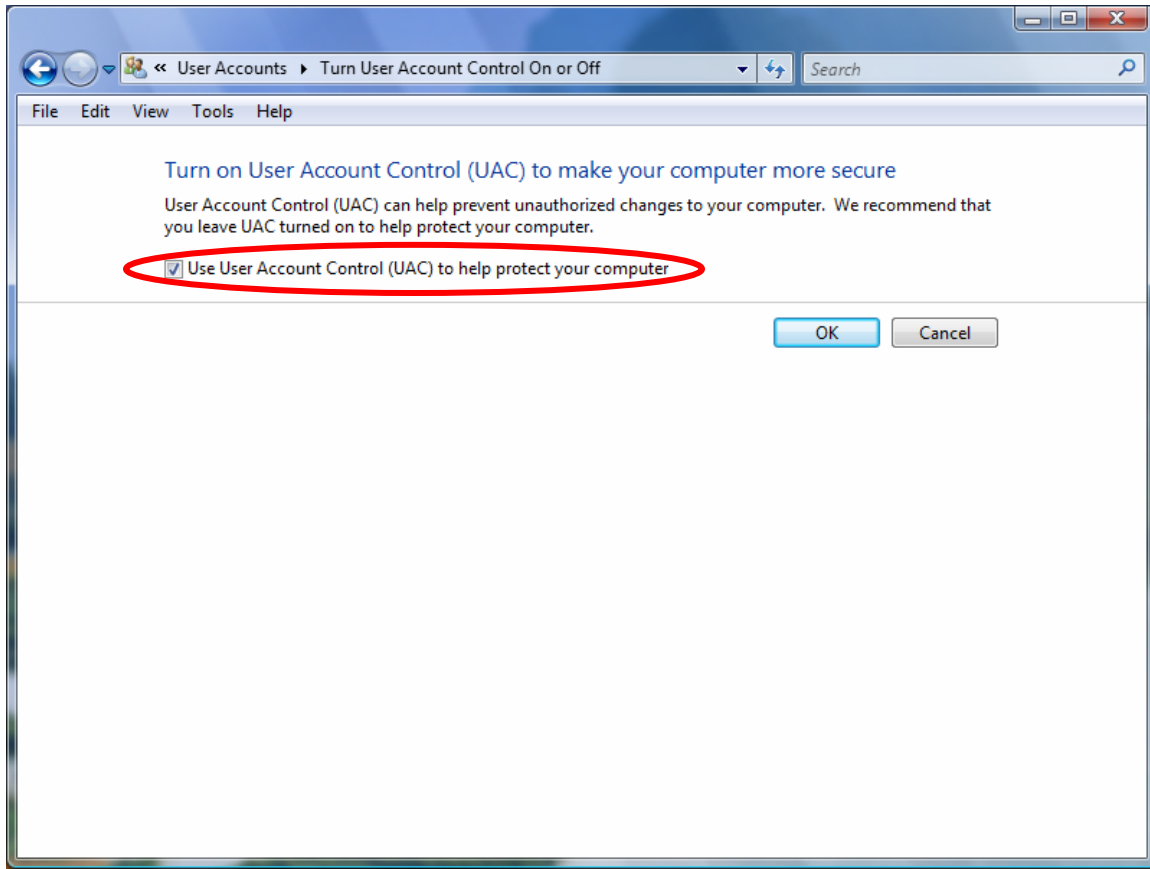


FIGURE 2—UN-CHECK THE USER ACCOUNT CONTROL (UAC) BOX AND CLICK OK

- 4 Turn User Account Control to OFF and click OK (Figure 2)
- 5 After exiting the CD, repeat steps 1-4 and turn the User Account Control (UAC) back ON

Turning the User Accounts Control OFF is part of VISTA's security system. Every time you open any non-Microsoft software, you are asked if you want to run that software or not. Although having the User Account Control turned ON protects you from some viruses, an updated add-on virus program should catch viruses with the UAC turned OFF.

You may have to re-start your system each time you change the UAC.
