Heat Illness Prevention

In June of this year, Cal/OSHA approved Heat Illness Prevention Standard §3395 in response to heat-related deaths in the state. The regulation mandates training of employers and supervisors to prevent heat illness in workers who are likely to suffer heat exposure, even if they are working outdoors for only a short period of time.

Safety professional Mark Aniello will discuss training on these topics during the seminar:

Environmental and personal risk factors for heat illness

Procedures for identifying, evaluating, and controlling exposures to such factors

Responsibility for reporting symptoms or signs of heat illness

Procedures for contacting emergency medical services
